
Dear Dr. Arnold:

I am writing on behalf of the APBA Board of Directors to thank you for having the Behavioral and Cognitive Psychology Specialty Council reconsider its decision to remove this organization from the Council. Regarding the two conditions for APBA's reinstatement on the Council that were laid out in your letter of February 13, 2013:

1. APBA supports the current version of the Behavior Analyst Certification Board's model licensing act, including the language stating "The provisions of this section shall not be construed as prohibiting or restricting the practice of any of the following:
 1. An individual authorized to practice Psychology within the State, so long as the applied behavior analysis services provided by the Licensed Psychologist are within the Licensed Psychologist's education, training and experience;"
 2. The Association for Behavior Analysis Autism Special Interest Group's Guidelines for Consumers is not an APBA document. We have, however, removed the current version of that document from the APBA website. We have also recommended to that group that they include in the revision of the Guidelines that is in progress now a statement that licensure in psychology is one appropriate professional credential for a supervisor of applied behavior analysis services for individuals with autism, provided that the licensed psychologist's scope of practice and scope of competence and training include applied behavior analysis.

The APBA Board has not seen a final revision of the Autism SIG Guidelines, so has made no decisions about endorsing the revised Guidelines or posting them on the APBA website.
